Brownlow M. Speer Appellate Advocacy Award

I salute my former (indeed, first) law partner, current law cohort, and friend Norman Zalkind, for his courage, skill, integrity, and loyalty. His guts are matched by his unwavering friendship.

We met in the Boston Police lock-up when he and I were both interviewing arrested hippies – I mistook Norman, wearing his bell-bottom pants, for a defendant! Early in his career, when he was doing drug and draft cases, he mastered the art of speaking to juries. All of his mannerisms and strategies tell us that he is deeply intuitive and worldly wise. He draws in people to pay attention, like a magnet.

I hope that younger members of the criminal defense bar are paying attention. There is much to learn from Norman.



And I salute my friend David Boeri, who in my view invented "electronic legal journalism" here in Boston at the same time friends at the *Boston Phoenix* were inventing a new kind of print legal journalism.

David started his career at WGBH-TV working with media visionary Christopher Lydon. When I met David, he was lugging a heavy camera doing interviews on the street at all hours. Lucky for us that David stayed in Boston and made it his 'hood. Now, as he covers the Bulger trial, we see how he incorporates the Web and its accessibility to documents and factoids. Journalists are supposed to speak truth-to-power; David does it with a megaphone, utterly unafraid, always uncorrupted. And he has a voice that demands attention, conveying, when appropriate, his respect for the person in front of his microphone.
